- Educational and social events organized to connect people to others with similar interests
- · A focus on health and wellness, not on frailty and disability
- A membership organization with one call or email for assistance
- Services provided by members or other volunteers and a small paid staff or by qualified community providers

Wider Horizons: Central Seattle's Village for Life serves people living in these neighborhoods and others: Capitol Hill, the Central District, Eastlake, First Hill, the International District, Madison Park, Madrona, Leschi, Montlake, Mt. Baker, Pike/Pine, and Yesler.

We opened in June of 2015 and as of March 2022 we have 107 members.

Memberships are priced at \$600 per year for an individual and \$900 for a household. Those with financial need can receive support for their membership.
